**ORDER FOR CLOSURE & DISCONNECTION OF ELECTRICITY**

In exercise of the powers conferred under Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and Rules made thereunder, in consideration of the Hazardous Waste (Management & Handling) Rules, 2003 and its subsequent amendments and in consideration of the inspection report dated 17-10-2006 the following units are hereby directed by the Board not to operate their units till further direction from the Board for the reasons stated below.:

2. **Prop.: Kader Ali, Jamtagarh, P. O. – Malikapur, Dist. – 24 Parganas (North)**
3. **M/s. Biswa Metal Works, Berunanpur, P. O. – Malikapur, Dist. – 24 Parganas (North), Prop.: Hasim Ali**
4. **Prop.: Kaliash Singh, Berunanpur, P. O. – Malikapur, Dist. – 24 Parganas (North)**
5. **M/s. MAS Enterprise, Taldharia, P. O. – Kore Chanditala, Dist. – 24 Parganas (North), Prop.: Sk. Abdul Majid, Shri Subhas Pal, Shri Ajit Saha**
- 6 **M/s. Bengal Metal Works, Taldharia, P. O. – Kore Chanditala, Dist. – 24 Parganas (North)**

- i. That, the said units are operating without obtaining “No Objection Certificate” and “Consent to Operate” from the Board.
- ii. That, the said units are operating without having valid Hazardous Waste authorisation violating the Hazardous Waste (Management & Handling) Rules, 2003 and its subsequent amendments thus attracting the provisions of the Hon’ble Supreme Court Order passed in W. P. (C) No.657 of 1995
- iii. That, the said units are operating without installing any pollution abatement system in their units.
- iv. That, the units are disposing their solid wastes which are hazardous in nature violating the Hazardous Waste (Management & Handling) Rules, 2003 and its subsequent Amendments. The units are also operating without having valid registration from the Central Pollution Control Board as required under the Provisions of the Rules for reprocessing lead containing hazardous waste

v. That the electricity connection of the said units should be disconnected forthwith.

The Secretary, WBSEB is requested to take action for disconnection of the electricity of the said units.

The closure order will take immediate effect and Officer-In-Charge, Barasat Police Station under W.B. Police, is directed to execute the Closure Order against the aforementioned unit and submit the compliance report to the State Board within seven days from the receipt of this Memo.

This direction has been issued to the Officer-In-Charge, Barasat Police Station and the Secretary, WBSEB Ltd., in conformity with the order of the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta dated 21-08-1998 and 28-04-1999 respectively.

Barrackpore Regional Office of the State Board is requested to take necessary steps for proper execution of the closure order and also visit the unit involving the local police station and Nodal Police Officer of the concerned district to oversee the proper execution of the closure order and also ensure the disconnection of electricity of the unit.

This has the approval of the Competent Authority.
