### **ORDER FOR CLOSURE AND DISCONNECTION OF ELECTRICITY**

In exercise of the powers conferred under Section 33A(a)(b) of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, under Section 31A(a)(b) of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and under Section 5(a)(b) of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and Rules made thereunder and after careful consideration of the records kept and maintained by the State Board, it has been decided that electricity of **M/s. R. P. Enterprise, located at 31/1B, Cossipore Road, P.S. Cossipore, Kolkata -700 002, West Bengal**, will be disconnected and closure order will be imposed for the following reasons and Consent of the said unit is also hereby withdrawn :-

That, the said unit is operating violating the environmental norms as fixed up under the aforementioned Acts, and rules made thereunder;

- ii. That, the said unit failed to comply with the directions issued by the State Board vide Memo no. 58/2A/Z-II/G/93-03/04, dated 21-04-2005, and also direction issued through record of proceedings dated 28-07-2006, vide Memo No. 1433(1-4)-2L/WPB-D(II)2006, dated 03-08-2006.
- iii. That, during inspection on 01-03-2007, it was observed the said unit has failed to take necessary measures to reduce the noise level generated from its manufacturing process within the stipulated time as fixed up by the State Board and bring the noise level within the permissible limit as fixed up under the aforementioned Acts and Rules made thereunder;

2.. The General Manager Operations (C & M), M/s. CESC Ltd., is requested to take immediate steps for disconnection of electricity of the aforementioned unit through his good office and send the compliance report to the State Board within seven days from the receipt of this notice.

3.. This closure order will take immediate effect and Officer in Charge, Cossipore Police Station, under W.B. Police, is directed to execute the Closure Order against the aforementioned unit and submit the compliance report to the State Board within seven days from the receipt of this Memo.

This direction has been issued to the Officer in Charge, Cossipore Police Station, and the General Manager Operations (C & M), M/s. CESC Ltd., in conformity with the order of the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta, dated 21-08-1998 and 28-04-1999.

It may be noted that the aforementioned unit, should not be allowed to operate in the premises where, the said unit is presently located, in any other name without prior permission of the State Board.

4.. The Consent to Operate issued in favour of the said unit is hereby withdrawn.
