DIRECTION

WHEREAS, **M/S. MAYA STEEL PRODUCTS** (hereinafter referred as the industry) operates its rolling mill at 35/2, Malipanchghora Street, P. S. – Liluah, Dist. – Howrah.

WHEREAS, the unit was inspected on 21-02-2007 by the Regional Office of the **WEST BENGAL POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD** (hereinafter referred as the Board). During inspection huge black emission from the stack was observed. High secondary emission from reverbaratory furnace was also observed.

WHEREAS, a hearing was conducted involving the industry on 27-04-2007 at the Head Office of the Board.

WHEREAS, Shri Satyapal Goyal, Proprietor of the Industry attended the hearing. He himself assured the Board that he will not operate the unit with such high emission and he acknowledged that the emission of black smoke as noted during the inspection will have to be controlled by proper maintenance of burners as also use of proper fuel. The proprietor also submitted that henceforth they will use furnace oil manufactured by designated oil companies like IOCL, BPCL or HPCL.

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and Rules made thereunder, **M/S. MAYA STEEL PRODUCTS** is hereby directed as follows

1. That, the industry is allowed one month time to ensure smoke less stack for compliance with the environmental standard in respect of particulate matter.
2. That, the industry should not use carbon black feed stock (CBFS)/Tar oil as fuel in their furnace.
3. That, henceforth the industry should use only furnace oil purchased from either Indian Oil Corporation Ltd., Bharat Petroleum Corporation Limited or Hindusthan Petroleum Corporation Limited. All the challans related to the purchase of such furnace oil from designated oil companies will have to be maintained by the industry and to be produced before the Board's Officials during their visit to the industry.
4. **That, the industry should submit pollution cost of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand only) by Demand Draft to be drawn on Service Branch, Kolkata/Banker's cheque in favour of the WEST BENGAL POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD within fifteen [15] days from the date hereof for non compliance of the environmental norms.**

In case of non-compliance of the above mentioned directions by the industry within the stipulated time, the Board may take regulatory action without any further reference

This has the approval of the Competent Authority.
