**REINFORCEMENT OF CLOSURE ORDER WITH DISCONNECTION OF ELECTRICITY**

WHEREAS, **M/S. B. C. SHAW & SONS** (hereinafter referred as the industry) operates its waste oil reprocessing unit located at 136, Narkeldanga Main Road, Kolkata – 700 011

WHEREAS, an inspection conducted by the officials of the WEST BENGAL POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD (hereinafter referred as the Board) on 18-05-2007 revealed that the industry is operating violating the Board's Closure Order issued as per the direction of the Hon'ble Supreme Court Order in W. P. (C) No.657 of 1995. It was also observed that the unit is continuing reprocessing of waste/used oil without obtaining registration from the Central Pollution Control Board as is required under the provision of Hazardous Waste (Management & Handling) Rules. Waste/Used oil reprocessing is being done using acid-clay process instead of vacuum distillation as permitted under the Rules.

WHEREAS, a hearing was conducted on 08-06-2007 involving the industry in the Head Office of the Board.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the facts and circumstance stated above the closure order issued against **M/S. B. C. SHAW & SONS** is reinforced under the provisions of Hazardous Waste (Management & Handling) Rules and its amendments as Notified under Environmental (Protection) Act, 1986. This is done in compliance with the Hon'ble Supreme Court Order in W. P. (C) No.657 of 1995. The electricity connection of **M/S. B. C. SHAW & SONS** will also be disconnected forthwith.

The General Manager – Operations (C & M), CESC LTD. is once again requested to disconnect the electricity connection of the industry in question forthwith.

The Officer-In-Charge, Narkeldanga Police Station under W. B. Police is once again directed to reinforce the Closure Order against the aforementioned unit and submit the compliance report to the State Board within seven days from the receipt of this Memo.

This direction has been issued to the Officer-In-Charge, Narkeldanga Police Station and the Secretary, WBSEB in conformity with the order of the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta dated 21-08-1998 and 28-04-1999 respectively.

The Environmental Engineer, Salt Lake Regional Office of the State Board is requested to take necessary steps for proper execution of the reinforcement closure order and also visit the units involving the local police station and Nodal Police Officer of the concerned district to oversee the proper execution of the closure order and also ensure the disconnection of electricity of the unit.

This has the approval of the Competent Authority.
