ORDER

WHEREAS M/S. MAA MANASA INDUSTRIES (PROP.: NARESH DEBNATH) AND M/S. NEW MAA MANASA INDUSTRIES (PROP.: SURESH DEBNATH). (hereinafter referred as the industries) both located at Vill.: - Bhandertikuri (Barisalpara), P. O. – Parulia, P. S. – Purbasthali, Dist. – Burdwan were called for public hearing in the office of the WEST BENGAL POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD (hereinafter referred as the Board) on 02-02-2007 in response to a public complaint alleging noise pollution from its' power looms and illegal operation of its' dyeing & bleaching units.

WHEREAS, after conducting the public hearing the Board issued following directions to **M/S. MAA MANASA INDUSTRIES (PROP.: NARESH DEBNATH) AND M/S. NEW MAA MANASA INDUSTRIES (PROP.: SURESH DEBNATH) :**

1. That, the industries will have to obtain "Consent-to-Operate" immediately from the Regional Office of the Board
2. The dying operation will have to be totally closed pending installation of effluent treatment plant to the satisfaction of the Board.
3. That, the industries will only operate between 8-00 A.M. to 8-00 P.M.

(However, the industries were subsequently allowed to operate between 6-00 A. M. to 10.00 P. M. extending the time of operation by four hours following an appeal from the industries.)

4. That, the industries will take appropriate measure for controlling noise emanating from the operation of the power looms so that it does not affect the local people.
5. That, the industries will not be allowed to increase the capacity of power loom units and their activity will be restricted to fifty (50) power looms for M/s. Maa Manasa Industries and eighty-two (82) power looms for M/s. New Maa Manasa Industries as are currently being operated
6. If the industries failed to control the noise limit within six months period, shifting order will be issued against the industries.

WHEREAS, the Board received a fresh complaint alleging that the units are violating the Board's Order as stated above issued through Memo No.:3322-7/WPBD-CONT(3107)/07 dated 06/07-03-2007.

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred under Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and Rules made thereunder the Board reinforce its earlier order issued through Memo No.:3322-7/WPBD-CONT(3107)/07 dated 06/07-03-2007 and direct **M/S. MAA MANASA INDUSTRIES (PROP.: NARESH DEBNATH) AND M/S. NEW MAA MANASA INDUSTREIS (PROP.: SURESH DEBNATH)** once again to strictly follow the following:

That, the industries will have to obtain "Consent-to-Operate" immediately from the Regional Office of the Board

1. The dying operation will have to be totally closed pending installation of effluent treatment plant to the satisfaction of the Board.
2. That, the industries will only operate between 6-00 A.M. to 10-00 P.M.
4. That, the industries will take appropriate measure for controlling noise emanating from the operation of the power looms so that it does not affect the local people.
5. That, the industries will not be allowed to increase the capacity of power loom units and their activity will be restricted to fifty (50) power looms for M/s. Maa Manasa Industries and eight two (82) power loom for M/s. New Maa Manasa Industries are currently being operated
6. If the industries failed to control the noise limit within six months period, shifting order will be issued against the industries.

In case of noncompliance by the industries, the Board will issue closure order of the units without any further reference.

This Officer-In-Charge, Purbasthali Police Station is directed to ensure that the units under reference immediately close its' dyeing operation and follow the other directions of the Board as mentioned above . This direction to the Officer-In-Charge, Purbasthali Police Station is given in conformity with the order of the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta dated 21-08-1998 and will submit a report to the Board.

This has the approval of the Competent Authority.
