### DIRECTION

WHEREAS, **M/S. MOHATA ENTERPRISES (P) LTD.** (hereinafter referred as the industry) operates its phenol formaldehyde resin manufacturing unit at Nendapur, P. O. – Jorepatki, P. S. – Mathabhanga, Dist. – Coochbehar.

WHEREAS, the unit was inspected by the Siliguri Regional Office of the WEST BENGAL POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD (hereinafter referred as the Board) on 24-04-2007. During inspection it was noted that the unit is operating without obtaining hazardous waste authorization and without commissioning of the Effluent Treatment Plant.

WHEREAS, a hearing was conducted in the Head Office of the Board on 06-07-2007 .

WHEREAS, in the hearing Shri Joy Krishna Choudhury, Works Manager submitted that they will obtain the authorization under Hazardous Waste (Management & Handling) Rules within seven days. He also submitted that they will install Effluent Treatment Plant to treat their liquid waste.

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred under Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and Rules made thereunder **M/S. MOHATA ENTERPRISES (P) LTD.**, located at Nendapur, P. O. – Jorepatki, P. S. – Mathabhanga, Dist. - Coochbehar is hereby directed as under :

1. That, six months time is allowed to the industry to install & commission the Effluent Treatment Plant to treat their liquid effluent and meet the liquid discharge standard.
2. That the industry will obtain authorization under the Hazardous Waste (Management & Handling) Rules from the Waste Management Cell of the Board at Head Office within seven days from the date of receipt of this order.
3. The industry will submit the compliance report after within six months to the Regional Office of the Board with a copy to the undersigned

In case of the non-compliance of the above directions by the industry within the stipulated time, the Board may have to issue necessary regulatory order without any further reference.

This has the approval of the Competent Authority.
