ORDER FOR CLOSURE INCLUDING DISCONNECTION OF ELECTRICITY

WHEREAS, **M/S. SHYAM DYEING & PROCESSING WORKS.,** (hereinafter referred as the industry) operates its dyeing & bleaching unit at 48/1, "X" Road, P. S. – Liluah, Howrah – 711 108

WHEREAS, the unit was inspected by the Howrah Regional Office of the WEST BENGAL POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD (hereinafter referred as the Board) on 22-05-2007. It was observed during the inspection that the unit operates a coal fired boiler with cyclone separator and wet scrubber as emission control system. During the inspection, the unit was operating the coal fired boiler keeping the pollution control system idle. The unit has also no effluent treatment system for treating its liquid waste. The unit is also operating without having valid "Consent-to-Operate" from the Board, which is the gross violation of the environmental statute.

WHEREAS, a hearing was conducted in the Head Office of the Board on 06-07-2007 involving the industry.

WHEREAS, in the hearing the Director of the industry submitted a document related to the submission of "Consent-to-Operate" in the year 2001. He also agreed during the hearing that the renewal application for "Consent-to-Operate" was not submitted thereafter.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the inspection report and the fact that the industry is operating without having valid "Consent-to-Operate" from the Board, discharging effluent without any treatment and operating its coal fired boiler without emission control system **M/S. SHYAM DYEING & PROCESSING WORKS is hereby closed by the Board** in exercise of the powers conferred under Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and Rules made thereunder. The electricity connection of **M/S. SHYAM DYEING & PROCESSING WORKS** will also be disconnected forthwith.

Suspension of closure order will be considered after compliance of the following direction subject to physical inspection of the same by the Regional Office of the Board.

1. The unit completes commissioning of adequate effluent treatment system for treating its liquid waste which is coloured in nature

2. The unit ensures compliance of particulate emission standard by continuous and proper functioning of its air pollution control system for coal fired boiler. The unit will have to ensure smokeless stack from the coal fired boiler
3. The unit obtains “Consent-to-Operate” after fulfillment of the above two conditions.

The Secretary, WBSEB is requested to disconnect the electricity connection of the industry in question forthwith.

The Officer-In-Charge, Liluah Police Station under W. B. Police is directed to execute the Closure Order against the aforementioned unit and submit the compliance report to the State Board within seven days from the date of receipt of this Memo.

This direction has been issued to the Officer-In-Charge, Liluah Police Station and the Secretary, WBSEB, in conformity with the order of the Hon’ble High Court, Calcutta dated 21-08-1998 and 28-04-1999 respectively.

The Environmental Engineer, Howrah Regional Office of the State Board is requested to take necessary steps for proper execution of the closure order and also visit the unit involving the local police station and Nodal Police Officer of the concerned district to oversee the proper execution of the closure order and also ensure the disconnection of electricity of the unit.
