SUSPENSION OF CLOSURE ORDER WITH RESTORATION OF ELECTRICITY

In consideration of the appeal made by **M/S. AMBAY BOARDS** located at 101, Foreshore Road, P. S. – Shibpur, Dist. – Howrah, PIN – 711 102 through its letter dated 22nd August, 2007 and the inspection report of the Board dated 23rd August, 2007 revealing that the industry has dismantled its coal fired boilers and installed oil fired thermic fluid heater with adequate height of chimney, the closure order issued by the Board vided Memo No. 1428-PCB/HOW/455-2005 dated 06/08-2007 is hereby withdrawn by the Board with the following conditions. The electricity connection of **M/S. AMBAY BOARDS** is also hereby restored.

1. That, the industry will have to obtain immediately NOC for installation of the oil fired thermic fluid heater from the Howrah Regional Office of the Board .
2. That, the industry will have to obtain immediately “Consent-to-Operate” for the same from Howrah Regional Office of the Board
3. That the industry will have to always comply with the stricter particulate emission standard (150 mg./Nm³) as notified by the Board.
4. That, the industry will always ensure smokeless stack during its manufacturing process.
5. That, the industry should only use fuel oil purchased from either Indian Oil Corporation Ltd., Bharat Petroleum Corporation Limited or Hindusthan Petroleum Corporation Limited. All the challans related to the purchase of such fuel oil from designated oil companies will have to be maintained by the industry and to be produced before the Board’s Officials during their visit to the industry.

This direction is issued in exercise of the power conferred Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and its subsequent amendments and Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and Rules made thereunder.

In case of non-compliance of the aforementioned directions by the said unit, the State Pollution Control Board may take recourse to its earlier order without any further reference.

This order has the approval of the Competent Authority.
