### SUSPENSION OF CLOSURE ORDER WITH RESTORATION OF ELECTRICITY

WHEREAS, **M/S. JAGADAMBA ISPAT PVT. LTD.** (hereinafter referred as the industry) operates its iron casting unit using two induction furnaces at Kadavita Road, Maheshpur, P. O. – Maheshpur, P. S. – Salanpur, Dist. – Burdwan.

WHEREAS, the industry was closed by the Board including disconnection of electricity for operating the induction furnaces without the pollution control system violating the NOC condition.

WHEREAS, further inspection of the unit on 24-08-2007 in response to the appeal of industry revealed that that unit has duly commissioned adequate emission control system.

Now in consideration of the inspection report dated 24-08-2007 and in consideration of the appeal made by the industry, the closure order against iron casting unit of **M/S. JAGADAMBA ISPAT PVT. LTD.** located at Kadavita Road, Maheshpur, P. O. – Maheshpur, Dist. – Burdwan, through its letter dated 23rd August 2007, the closure order issued by the Board through Memo No. 1516-WPBD-RED(BWN)/CONT(561)/06 dated 14/16-08-2007 is hereby withdrawn till further order with the following conditions. The electricity connection of **M/S. JAGADAMBA ISPAT PVT. LTD.** is also hereby restored.

1. That, the industry will ensure compliance of the emission standard through proper functioning of the emission control system.
2. That, the industry will always operate its pollution control systems during its manufacturing process.
3. That, the industry will take a shut down of its manufacturing process whenever the pollution abatement system fails to function for whatever reasons and the same should be intimated to the Board.
4. That, the industry should submit Pollution Cost of Rs.1.00 Lakhs (Rupees One Lakh only) by Demand Draft payable at Service Branch, Kolkata/Banker's Cheque within fifteen days from the date hereof in favour of the WEST BENGAL POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD for starting operation of the induction furnace without completing the commissioning of emission control system.

The Secretary, Damodar Valley Corporation, is hereby requested to restore the electricity connection of the industry immediately.

This direction is issued in exercise of the power conferred Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and its subsequent amendments and Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and Rules made thereunder.

In case of non-compliance of the aforementioned directions by the said unit, the State Pollution Control Board may take recourse to its earlier order without any further reference.

This order has the approval of the Competent Authority.
