SUSPENSION OF CLOSURE ORDER

WHEREAS, **M/S. SARAT EXPORTS PVT. LTD.** [hereinafter referred as the industry] operates a dyeing & bleaching unit at Vill.: - Kalachara, P. O. & P. S. – Chanditala, District – Hooghly.

WHEREAS, the industry was instructed to suspend its operation for one month by the **WEST BENGAL POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD** (hereinafter referred as the Board) for modification/improvement of pollution abatement system during the hearing which was held on 10-08-2007 in response to a public complaint for violation of liquid discharge standard as well as the particulate emission standard.

WHEREAS, the industry confirmed closing the unit through a letter dated 20-08-2007.

Now in consideration of the appeal made by the industry (letter dated 27-08-2007) and the inspection report dated 06-09-2007, **M/S. SARAT EXPORTS PVT. LTD.** is once again allowed to start its manufacturing operation and to continue the same till 31st October, 2007 for assessing the efficacy of the pollution abatement systems with the following conditions:

1. That, the industry will have to be complied the liquid discharge standards stipulated by the Board by efficient functioning of the Effluent Treatment Plant within 15-10-2007.
2. That, the industry will have to complete commissioning of Bag Filter in its husk fired boiler by 15-10-2007 for meeting the particulate emission standard
3. That, the industry should obtain permission from the Irrigation and Waterways Department, Government of West Bengal for discharging their treated effluent into Janai Canal after necessary compliance of discharge standard including making its colourless.
4. That, the industry should arrange proper way of disposal of the ash inside a baffled area with arrangement of water sprinkling. Transportation of ash from the unit to the site of disposal should be made in such a way that spillage is avoided.

In case of non- compliance of the above direction by the industry, the Board may take stringent regulatory action without any further reference in the matter.

This has the approval of the Competent Authority.
