### CLOSURE ORDER WITH DISCONNECTION OF ELECTRICITY

WHEREAS, **M/S. SAGAR OIL 2001**, (hereinafter referred as the industry) having its lubricants blending unit at 244, Badu Road (E), New Barrackpore, Kolkata – 700 131.

WHEREAS, it revealed from the documents submitted by M/s. Eveready Industries India Limited (Metal & Ore Division) that M/s. SAGAR OIL, 2001 purchased used oil from them by showing “Consent-to-Operate” issued by the DIC, 24 Parganas (North). The industry can not legally procure used oil being a hazardous waste as per provision 19 of Hazardous Waste (Management & Handling) Rules, 2003 amendment without obtaining necessary registration from Central Pollution Control Board for reprocessing of used/waste oil using vacuum distillation technology. The industry however does not possess the registration from the Central Pollution Control Board for either procurement of waste/used oil or reprocessing the same. Thus the industry violated the provisions of the Hazardous Waste (Management & Handling) Rules, 1989 and its subsequent amendments attracting the Order of the Hon’ble Supreme Court of India passed in W. P. (C) No.657 of 1995.

WHEREAS, a technical hearing of the industry was conducted in the Head Office of the Board on 15-10-2007 for the above violation.

WHEREAS, the industry did not appear in the hearing.

NOW THEREFORE, considering the violation of the environmental statute by the industry and in consideration of the Order of the Hon’ble Supreme Court of India, **M/S. SAGAR OIL 2001** is hereby closed by the Board. The electricity connection of **M/S. SAGAR OIL 2001** will also be disconnected forthwith.

This order is issued in exercise of the powers conferred under Hazardous Waste (Management & Handling) Rules, 1989 and its subsequent amendments, Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and Rules made thereunder.

The Secretary, WBSEB is requested to disconnect the electricity connection of the industry in question forthwith.

The Officer-In-Charge, Barasat Police Station under W. B. Police is directed to execute the Closure Order against the aforementioned unit and submit the compliance report to the State Board within seven days from the receipt of this Memo.

This direction has been issued to the Officer-In-Charge, Barasat Police Station and the Secretary, WBSEB in conformity with the order of the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta dated 21-08-1998 and 28-04-1999 respectively.

Environmental Engineer, Barrackpore Regional Office of the State Board is requested to take necessary steps for proper execution of the closure order and also visit the units involving the local police station and Nodal Police Officer of the concerned district to oversee the proper execution of the closure order and also ensure the disconnection of electricity of the unit.

This order has the approval of the Competent Authority.
