CLOSURE WITH DISCONNECTION WITH ELECTRICITY

WHEREAS, **M/S. MILLENIUM FORGE & ENGINEERS PVT. LTD.**, (hereinafter referred as the industry) operating its forging unit at 20, Belur Road, P. O. – Liluah, Dist.- Howrah , PIN - 711 204 was closed by the Board through an order dated 16-05-2007 for operating its coal-fired boiler without operating the pollution abatement system.

WHEREAS, the closure was suspended under following conditions through an order dated 12-06-2007, in due consideration of the appeal made by the unit.

- I. That, the unit should upgrade its air pollution control system for the coal fired boiler within 30th November, 2007 to ensure compliance of particulate emission standard as also smokeless stack.
- II. That, the unit should not operate its boiler without operating the pollution control system attached to it.
- III. That, the unit was imposed with a Bank Guarantee of Rs.1.00 Lakh for ensurance of the compliance of the 1 & 2 above.

WHEREAS, a further inspection of the unit on 16-12-2007 [after the expiry of the stipulated dated for compliance i.e. 30-11-2007] once again revealed that the unit was operating its coal-fired boiler without operating pollution control system attached to the boiler repeating the offence committed earlier.

WHEREAS, a technical hearing of the industry was conducted at the Head Office of the Board on 31-01-2008.

NOW THEREFORE, considering the facts and circumstance stated above, **M/S. MILLENIUM FORGE & ENGINEERS PVT. LTD.** is hereby closed by the Board for noncompliance of the Board's Order dated 12-06-2007 The Bank Guarantee amounting to Rs.1.00 Lakh (Rupees One Lakh only) is also ordered to be forfeited.

The electricity connection of the industry will also be disconnected immediately.

The General Manager – Operations (C & M), M/S. CESC LTD. is requested to take action for disconnection of the electricity of the said unit.

The closure order will take immediate effect and Officer-In-Charge, Golabari Police Station under W.B. Police, is directed to execute the Closure Order against the aforementioned unit and submit the compliance report to the State Board within seven days from the receipt of this Memo.

This direction has been issued to the Officer-In-Charge, Goalbari Police Station and the General Manager – Operations (C & M), M/S. CESC LTD., in conformity with the order of the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta dated 21-08-1998 and 28-04-1999 respectively.

The Environmental Engineer Howrah Regional Office of the State Board is requested to take necessary steps for proper execution of the closure order and also visit the unit involving the local police station and Nodal Police Officer of the concerned district to oversee the proper execution of the closure order and also ensure the disconnection of electricity of the unit.

This direction is issued in exercise of the powers conferred under Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and rules made thereunder.

This order has the approval of the Competent Authority.
