### **CLOSURE ORDER WITH DISCONNECTION OF ELECTRICITY**

WHEREAS, **M/S. PUNJAB EATING HOUSE** (hereinafter referred as the unit) operates its eatery at 1/A, Topsia Road, Kolkata – 700 039

WHEREAS, the unit was allowed six months time from the date of issuance of the direction vide Memo No.:3605-WBPCB-RO-I/NOC/743/2004 dated 30-03-007 by the **WEST BENGAL POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD** (hereinafter referred as the Board) for change its coal-fired chullahs to gas or diesel-fired ones. This direction was issued following a public complaint and subsequent public hearing conducted by the Board on 02-03-2007.

WHEREAS, the Board further conducted an inspection on 29-02-2008 of the unit in question after receiving a fresh public complaint that the unit is still continuing its operation violating the Board's order. The inspection report also confirmed the allegation.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the public complaint and the inspection report **M/S. PUNJAB EATING HOUSE** is hereby closed by the Board for violating the Board Direction referred above. The electricity connection of **M/S. PUNJAN EATING HOUSE** is also ordered to be disconnected immediately.

The General Manager – Operations (C&M) is requested to make arrangement to disconnect the electricity connection of the unit in question forthwith.

Suspension of closure will be considered only after the industry complies with the following condition.

1. That, the unit changes its coal-fired chullahas to gas or diesel fired ones.

The closure order will take immediate effect and Officer-In-Charge, Topsia Police Station under Kolkata Police, is directed to execute the Closure Order against the aforementioned unit and submit the compliance report to the State Board within seven days from the receipt of this Memo.

This direction has been issued to the Officer-In-Charge, Topsia Police Station and the General Manager – Operations(C&M), **M/S. CESC LTD.**, in conformity with the order of the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta dated 21-08-1998 and 28-04-1999 respectively.

Environmental Engineer, Camac Street Regional Office of the State Board is requested to take necessary steps for proper execution of the closure order and also visit the unit involving the local police station and Nodal Police Officer of the concerned district to oversee the proper execution of the closure order and also ensure the disconnection of electricity of the unit.

This order is issued in exercise of the power conferred under Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and Rules made thereunder.

This order has the approval of the Competent Authority.
