DIRECTION

WHEREAS, **M/S. SUPER FORGING & STEELS LIMITED (UNIT-II)** [hereinafter referred as the Industry] operates its forging unit located at 15/B, Belur Road, Liluah, Dist. – Howrah.

WHEREAS, the report inspection carried out 5th March, 2008 by the Officials of the **WEST BENGAL POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD** (hereinafter referred as the Board) revealed that the industry was operating its coal-fired boiler without operating the emission control system. Emission of dense black smoke was observed during the time of inspection. Corroborative evidence through photography of such emission was taken during the time of inspection.

WHEREAS, a technical hearing of the industry was conducted at the Head Office of the Board on 02-05-2008.

WHEREAS, the General Manager of the industry appearing in the hearing submitted that they are in the process of upgrading the air pollution control devices, which will be completed within May, 2008

NOW THEREFORE, in due consideration of the inspection report and the submitted made by the industry during hearing, **M/S. SUPER FORGING & STEELS LIMITED (UNIT-II)** is hereby directed as under:

1. That, the industry is allowed time up to June 15, 2008 to complete the upgradation of its pollution abatement system for complying with the particulate emission standard ensuring smokeless stack.
2. That, the industry should submit a Bank Guarantee (proforma enclosed) for Rs.2.00 Lakhs (Rupees Two Lakhs only) valid for twelve [12] months within seven (7) days from the date of issuance of the direction as an assurance for complying with the direction 1 above as agreed by the industry.

In case of noncompliance of the above directions within the stipulated time, the Board may issue necessary regulatory order without any further reference in the matter.

This direction has been issued in exercise of the powers conferred under Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and Rules made thereunder after being approved by the Competent Authority.
