DIRECTION

WHEREAS, **M/S. CARNATION INDUSTRIES LTD.**, (hereinafter referred as the industry) operates its cast iron foundry unit at 23, "Q" Road, Belgachia, P. O. – Netajigarh, P. S. – Liluah, Dist. – Howrah, PIN – 711 108.

WHEREAS, in consideration of the results related to noncompliance of particulate emission standard, the foundry was called for a hearing in the Board Office in March, 2007 and allowed time up to October, 2007 for compliance of standard through improving the efficiency of emission control system

WHEREAS, the industry failed to comply with the particulate emission standard after the expiry of the stipulated period as was evident through monitoring in April, 2008.

WHEREAS, a technical hearing of the industry was conducted at the Head Office of the Board on 02-05-2008.

NOW THEREFORE, considering the failure of the industry to comply with the standard even after providing sufficient time to do so, **M/S. CARNATION INDUSTRIES LTD.** is

1. Penalized through imposition of a pollution cost of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand only) payable by Banker's Cheque/Demand Draft payable at Service Branch, Kolkata in favour of the **WEST BENGAL POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD.**
2. Considering the degree of noncompliance the industry is allowed further time of three months from the date of issuance of this direction to comply with the particulate emission standard through modification/upgradation/improvement of the efficiency of the emission control system under a Bank Guarantee of Rs.1.00 Lakh (Rupees One Lakh only) to be submitted as per proforma enclosed in favour of **THE WEST BENGAL POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD.**
3. In case of noncompliance after the expiry of the time limit allowed for compliance, the Board may have to consider issuing a stricter regulatory direction including closure.

The Pollution Cost and the Bank Guarantee will have to be submitted within fifteen days from the date of issuance of this direction.

This direction is issued under Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and Rules made thereunder after being approved from the Competent Authority.
