DIRECTION

WHEREAS, **M/S. SHREE MADHAV EDIBLE PRODUCTS LIMITED** (hereinafter referred as the industry) operates its vegetable oil producing unit at Vill.: - Rapnarayanpur, P. O. – Jakpur, P. S. – Kharagpur, Dist. – Paschim Medinipur, PIN – 721 302.

WHEREAS, the report of inspection carried out by the Officials of the WEST BENGAL POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD on 14-03-2008 revealed that the unit has installed a husk-fired thermic fluid heater without obtaining “Consent-to-Establish” from the Board. This thermic fluid heater is proposed to replace 3 nos. oil fired thermic fluid heater for which they industry submitted “Consent-to-Establish” application before the Board. Dense black smoke was also observed from the stack of the 12 MT./hr. husk-fired boiler though the boiler is having multi cyclone as emission control system.

WHEREAS, a technical hearing of the industry was conducted at the Head Office of the Board on 02-05-2008.

WHEREAS, the Director of the industry appearing in the hearing appealed before the Board to allow six months time for installing Bag Filter as an additional emission control system for the husk-fired boiler.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the appeal made by the industry during the hearing **M/S. SHREE MADHAV EDIBLE PRODUCTS LIMITED** is hereby directed by the Board as under:

1. That the unit is allowed time up to August, 2008 to complete commissioning of Bag Filter as an additional emission control system for the husk-fired thermic fluid heater to comply with the emission standard.
2. That, the industry will have to submit fresh application immediately for obtaining “Consent-to-Establish” and “Consent-to-Operate” for installing and operating the husk-fired thermic fluid heater replacing the three nos. oil-fired thermic fluid heaters with bag filter as emission control system.

In case of noncompliance of the above directions within the stipulated period of time, the Board may have to take stricter regulatory action without any further reference in the matter.

This order has been issued under the provisions of Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and Rules made thereunder after taking due approval of the Competent Authority.
