### CLOSURE ORDER

WHEREAS, **M/S. B. S. RUBBER INDUSTRIES** (hereinafter referred as the industry) operates its rubber goods manufacturing unit at 92, Canal Street, P. O. – Sreebhumi, Kolkata – 700 048.

WHEREAS, the **WEST BENGAL POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD** (hereinafter referred as the Board) received a public complaint from the residents of the local area alleging sound pollution and spreading of pungent gases through out the day and night and causing health hazards.

WHEREAS, during inspection on 29-04-2008 the unit could not produce the statutory permission from the Board i.e. “Consent-to-Operate”, which is a violation of the environmental statutes.

WHEREAS, the unit was called for hearing on 02-05-2008 in the Head Office of the Board. During the hearing the unit was directed to submit the “Consent-to-Operate” certificate issued by the Board within ten days from the date of hearing.

WHEREAS, the unit was again called for hearings on 16-05-2008 and 28-05-2008 in the Head Office of the Board as they failed to comply with the Board’s direction as referred above. But on both the occasions the unit did not appear in the hearing.

**NOW THEREFORE**, considering the fact that the unit has started operating without obtaining “Consent-to-Operate” from the Board violating the environmental statutes, **M/S. B. S. RUBBER INDUSTRIES** is hereby closed by the Board.

This order has been issued under the provisions of Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and Rules made thereunder after taking due approval of the Competent Authority.

The Officer-In-Charge, Lake Town Police Station under W. B. Police is directed to execute the Closure Order against the aforementioned unit and submit the compliance report to the State Board within seven days from the receipt of this Memo.

This direction has been issued to the Officer-In-Charge, Lake Town Police Station in conformity with the order of the Hon’ble High Court, Calcutta dated 21-08-1998.

The Environmental Engineer, Salt Lake Regional Office of the State Board is requested to take necessary steps for proper execution of the closure order and also visit the units involving the local police station and Nodal Police Officer of the concerned district to oversee the proper execution of the closure order.
