SUSPENSION OF CLOSURE ORDER WITH RESTORATION OF ELECTRICITY

WHEREAS, **M/S. PUNJAB EATING HOUSE** (hereinafter referred as the eatery) having its eatery at 1/A, Topsia Road, Kolkata – 700 039

WHEREAS, the eatery was closed by the Board on 18-04-2008 for failing to dismantle the coal-fired chullas and change the same to gas/diesel fired ones within the stipulated time as was directed by the Board on 30-03-2007.

WHEREAS, in response to a letter for the Ld. Lawyer of the eatery dated 07-05-2008 the Board intimated the eatery that suspension of closure will be considered only after compliance of the following directions:

1. Dismantling the coal-fired ovens/chullahs
2. Obtaining permission for commercial use of LPG cylinder.

WHEREAS, the eatery submitted a prayer for withdrawal of closure order and restoration of electricity with submission that they have dismantled the coal-fired ovens/chullahs and obtained permission for commercial use of LPG

WHEREAS, the Board officials made an inspection of the eatery on 04-02-2009 and found that the eatery has dismantled the coal-fired ovens/chullahs.

WHEREAS, the eatery through a letter dated 19-03-2009 submitted a copy of the official permission for commercial use of LPG from IOC for cooking purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, considering the facts and circumstances as stated above, the closure order issued by the Board vide Memo No.201-WBPCB-RO-I/NOC/743/2004 dated 18-04-2008 against **M/S. PUNJAB EATING HOUSE**, located at 1A, Topsia Road, Kolkata – 700 039 is hereby withdrawn. The electricity connection of the eating house is also ordered to be restored immediately.

The General Manager – Operations (C&M), M/S. CESC LTD., is requested to take necessary arrangement for restoration of electricity of the eatery immediately.

This order is issued in exercise of the powers conferred Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and Rules made thereunder.
