### **DIRECTION**

**WHEREAS, M/S. NIRMAL DYEING & PRINTING (P) LTD.** (hereinafter referred as the industry) engaged in block and screen printing of saris located at Vill. – Delhi Road, Chotobelu, P. O. – Belumilky, P. S. – Serampore, Dist. – Hooghly.

**WHEREAS,** the unit was inspected by the Officials of the **WEST BENGAL POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD** (hereinafter referred as the Board) on 11-12-2008, which revealed that all the four boilers were being operated without functioning of the emission control system. The fourth boiler was operating without even any chimney attached to the same. The effluent treatment system was also found in defunct condition and the untreated liquid effluent was being discharged directly to a nearby canal.

**WHEREAS,** the unit did not appear for hearing earlier called by the Regional Office of the Board.

**WHEREAS,** the unit was further called for a technical hearing before the Technical Committee at the Head Office of the Board on 24-04-2009.

**WHEREAS,** the Director of the industry appearing in the hearing prayed for allowing time to install the emission control system for the boilers and commission effluent treatment plant to comply with the standards.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** considering the noncompliance of the industry as recorded above and the submission made by the industry, **M/S. NIRMAL DYEING & PRINTING (P) LTD.** is hereby directed as under:

1. That, the unit is allowed time up to 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2009 to install emission control system for the coal-fired baby boilers along with adequate height of stacks to ensure smokeless stack and comply with the emission standard.
2. That within this period the unit will have to modify/upgrade its effluent treatment system to treat its liquid effluent to comply with the liquid discharge standard.

3. That, the industry should submit a Bank Guarantee (proforma enclosed) of Rs.1.00 Lakhs (Rupees One Lakh only) valid for twelve [12] months as an assurance of compliance of the above direction within the stipulated time period. The Bank Guarantee will have to be submitted in favour of the WEST BENGAL POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD within fifteen days from the date of issuance of the direction.

This direction is issued in exercise of the powers conferred under Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and Rules made thereunder after being approved by the Competent Authority.
