### **SUSPENSION OF CLOSURE ORDER INCLUDING RESTORATION OF ELECTRICITY**

**WHEREAS, M/s. Asian Metal Industries** (hereinafter referred as the industry) is a secondary lead smelting unit at Jalan Industrial Park, Mouza – Dhulagori, P.S. Sankrail, Dist. Howrah.

**WHEREAS,** the industry was closed by the **WEST BENGAL POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD** (hereinafter referred as the Board) on 22.09.2008 for operating the unit without obtaining Registration from the Central Pollution Control Board, and Rules “Authorisation from the Board under the Hazardous Wastes (Management, Handling & Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2008.

**WHEREAS,** the industry submitted the application to the Central Pollution Control Board on 16.07.2009 for registration as recycler of lead bearing wastes.

**WHEREAS,** the industry has become a member of the Common Hazardous Waste Treatment, Storage & Disposal Facility at Haldia, Purba Midnapore, West Bengal.

**WHEREAS,** the industry made an appeal before the State Board through its letter dated 08.12.2009 for suspension of closure including restoration of electricity.

Now, **WHEREAS,** in due consideration of the submission of the registration application to the Central Pollution Control Board as also in the view of compliance of the directions of the Board, the closure order vide memo no. 1868-2S(HW)-2365/2008 dated 22/23.09.2008 issued by the Board against **M/s. ASIAN METAL INDUSTRIES** is hereby suspended with the following conditions :

1. The unit should not operate / procure / reprocess non-ferrous hazardous wastes without obtaining “Registration” from the Central Pollution Control Board.
2. The electricity connection of the industry is to be restored immediately. The Director (HR), WBSEDCL is hereby requested to restore the electricity of the industry in question immediately.
3. The directions is issued in exercise of the powers conferred under the provisions of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, Hazardous Wastes (Management, Handling & Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2008, especially notified under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
