CLOSURE ORDER WITH DISCONNECTION OF ELECTRICITY

In exercise of the powers conferred under Section 33A of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and Rules made thereunder and in due consideration of the report of inspection by the Board officials dated 12/11/2009, **M/s. Tara Dyeing** (hereinafter referred as the industry) operating its dyeing & bleaching industry at **22F, Lock Gate Road, Kolkata – 700 002** is hereby closed by the Board for the following reasons:

- 1) That, the industry is operating without valid ‘Consent to Operate’ from the Board.
- 2) That, the industry is discharging its process effluent directly to the KMC sewer without any treatment.
- 3) That, the industry failed to complete the construction of effluent treatment plant by 31/12/2006, violating the conditions of the last “Consent to Operate” which expired on 31/12/2006.

The electricity connection of the industry is ordered to be disconnected forthwith.

The General Manager – Operations (C&M), CESC Ltd., is requested to take necessary steps for disconnection of electricity of the industry immediately.

The closure order will take immediate effect and the Officer-in-Charge, Cossipore Police Station, Kolkata is directed to execute the closure order against the aforementioned industry and submit the compliance report to the State Board within seven (07) days from the receipt of this Memo.

This direction has been issued to the Officer-in-Charge, Cossipore Police Station and M/s. CESC Ltd. in conformity with the order of the Hon’ble High Court, Calcutta dated 21/08/1998 and 28/04/1999 respectively.

Environmental Engineer, Salt Lake Regional Office of the State Board is requested to take necessary steps for proper execution of the closure order and ensure the disconnection of electricity of the industry and also visit the unit involving the local police station and Nodal Police Officer.

This order has the approval of the Competent Authority.
