### **CLOSURE ORDER WITH DISCONNECTION OF ELECTRICITY**

In due consideration of the public complaint and the report of inspection dated 31/03/2010 by the officials of **West Bengal Pollution Control Board** (hereinafter referred to as the Board), **M/s. Indian Machinery** (hereinafter referred to as the industry) located at **8, Munshi Bazar Road, Kolkata – 700 015, KMC Ward No. 59, PS – Entally** is hereby closed by the Board with the following reasons :-

- 1) The industry is operating without any valid Consent from the Board.
- 2) The activity of the industry falls under Orange category and under the present siting policy of the Board, the industry is not permitted to operate at its present location since it was established in the year 2009.
- 3) The officials of the Board were prevented from inspecting the industry by Shri Anil Kumar Shaw, son of Shri Parameswar Shaw, proprietor.

**The electricity connection of the unit is ordered to be disconnected forthwith.**

The General Manager – Operations (C&M), CESC Ltd., is requested to take necessary steps for disconnection of electricity of the industry immediately.

The closure order will take immediate effect and the Officer-in-Charge, Entally Police Station, Kolkata is directed to execute the closure order against the aforementioned industry and submit the compliance report to the Board within seven days from the receipt of this Memo.

This direction has been issued to the Officer-in-Charge, Entally Police Station and M/s. CESC Ltd. in conformity with the order of the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta dated 21/08/1998 and 28/04/1999 respectively.

The Environmental Engineer, Camac Street Regional Office of the Board is requested to take necessary steps for proper execution of the closure order and also visit the industry involving the local police station and Nodal Police Officer.

This direction is issued in exercise of the powers conferred under the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and Rules made thereunder.

This has the approval of the Competent Authority.
