CLOSURE ORDER WITH DISCONNECTION OF ELECTRICITY

In due consideration of the public complaint and the report of inspection dated 24/02/2010 by the officials of **West Bengal Pollution Control Board** (hereinafter referred to as the Board), the following industries - **i) M/s. Shibpur Gate (Grill Factory), ii) Grill Factory – Jayanta Das** located at **Nirmala Apartment, 777/1, Sarat Chatterjee Road, Howrah – 711 104** are hereby closed by the Board with the following reasons:-

- 1) The units are operating without any valid Consent from the Board or licenses from the local body.
- 2) Both the units fall under Orange category and are not permitted to operate in Howrah Municipal Corporation area.
- 3) Although being provided the opportunity to appear for hearing on 03/04/2010, nobody appeared which proves the utter disregard for the directions issued by the Board.

The electricity connection of the units is ordered to be disconnected forthwith.

The General Manager – Operations (C&M), CESC Ltd., is requested to take necessary steps for disconnection of electricity of the units immediately.

The closure order will take immediate effect and the Officer-in-Charge, Shibpur (Chatterjihat) Police Station under West Bengal Police is directed to execute the closure order against the aforementioned units and submit the compliance reports to the Board within seven days from the receipt of this Memo.

This direction has been issued to the Officer-in-Charge, Shibpur (Chatterjihat) Police Station and M/s. CESC Ltd. in conformity with the order of the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta dated 21/08/1998 and 28/04/1999 respectively.

The Environmental Engineer, Howrah Regional Office of the Board is requested to take necessary steps for proper execution of the closure order and also visit the units involving the local police station and the Nodal Police Officer.

This direction is issued in exercise of the powers conferred under the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and has the approval of the Competent Authority.
