CLOSURE ORDER WITH DISCONNECTION OF ELECTRICITY

In due consideration of the public complaint and the report of inspection dated 26/11/2009 by officials of the West Bengal Pollution Control Board (hereinafter referred to as the Board) and in continuation to the Record of proceedings issued on 24/03/2010 vide memo No. 1741-PCB/HOW/119-2009, **M/s. Annapurna Engineering Works**, (Proprietor Sri Anupam Dalui) (hereinafter referred to as the industry) located at 11/1, Dharani Dhar Mallik Lane, P.O. & P.S. Bantra, Dist. Howrah, Pin - 711101 is hereby closed by the Board due to the following reasons :-

That the industry has no valid consent of the Board which is a statutory requirement for any industry to operate.

That the industry is creating environmental hazards in the vicinity due to noise pollution.

The electricity connection of the unit is ordered to be disconnected forthwith.

The General Manager – Operations (C&M), CESC Ltd., is requested to take necessary steps for disconnection of electricity of the industry immediately.

The closure order will take immediate effect and Officer-in-Charge, Bantra P.S. Howrah is directed to execute closure order against the aforementioned industry and submit compliance report to the Board within seven days from receipt of this Memo.

This direction has been issued to the Officer-in-Charge, Bantra Police Station and the General Manager – Operations (C&M), CESC Ltd. in conformity with the order of the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta dated 21/08/1998 and 28/04/1999 respectively.

The Environmental Engineer, Howrah Regional Office of the Board is requested to take necessary steps for proper execution of the closure order and also visit the industry involving local police station and Nodal Police Officer.

This direction is issued in exercise of the powers conferred under the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and Rules made thereunder.

This has approval of the Competent Authority.
