ORDER

WHEREAS M/s. Shiva Glass Works Co. Ltd. (hereinafter referred to as the industry) operates its glass items manufacturing unit at 128, B.T. Road, Kolkata – 700 108, P.O. & P.S. Baranagar.

WHEREAS the industry is engaged in production of glass bottle, glass jar, glass tube, chimney etc. using broken glass, soda ash and silica as raw material.

WHEREAS the industry was inspected by officials of the West Bengal Pollution Control Board (hereinafter referred to as the Board) on 06/11/2009 when it was in operation. It has one coal-fired melting furnace. The furnace is connected to ventury scrubber leading to a stack of height 30 mtrs. from G.L. The scrubber was in operation during inspection. During entry of inspecting officer dense black smoke was observed from the stack attached to the furnace. The condition of the stack improved after the exit of the inspecting officer.

WHEREAS the industry was called for a hearing by the Board on 20/04/2010 due to the heavy emission noticed during inspection.

WHEREAS the Director of the industry appearing in the hearing submitted that he was not competent enough to deal with the technical aspect of the industry and suggested that the above non-compliance may have occurred due to the emission control system being old. He requested for a time upto 31st May, 2010 to rectify the defects in the system.

NOW THEREFORE, considering the above observations, submission of Director of the industry and recommendations of the Technical Committee, the Board is hereby pleased to issue following directions to the aforementioned industry :

- a. The industry will ensure complete rectification / upgradation of the emission control system within **31st May, 2010**. The progress in this regard will be observed by the Board Officials and if after the stipulated time period, the industry is found to be still non-complying, the Board may take stricter regulatory action against the industry.
- b. The industry should submit a **Bank Guarantee** (proforma enclosed) for Rs.2,00,000/- (Rupees Two Lakhs) only, valid for twelve [12] months within fifteen [15] days from the date of issue of this Order in favour of the **WEST BENGAL POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD**, as a part of their commitment to the Board to rectify / upgrade the emission control system.

The Environmental Engineer – Salt Lake Regional Office, WBPCB is directed to inspect the industry by mid June 2010 to ascertain its performance and compliance with the aforesaid directions. If the industry is again found to operate violating the environmental norms and the aforesaid directions, stricter regulatory action including closure with disconnection of electricity will be imposed.

This direction is issued in exercise of powers conferred under provision of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and Rules made thereunder.
