DIRECTION

WHEREAS, M/s. JAYPEE ALLOY & CASTINGS PVT. LTD. (hereinafter referred to as the industry) operates its alloy steel and mild steel ingot manufacturing unit at Vill. - Banghihati (Simla), NH-2, Delhi Road, P.O. Mullickpara, P.S.-Serampore, Dist.- Hooghly, Pin – 712 203.

WHEREAS, the industry was inspected on 07/04/2010 and 10/04/2010 by the officials of **WEST BENGAL POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD** (hereinafter referred to as the Board). On both occasions huge fugitive emission was observed arising from the industry and engulfing the entire surrounding area. The emission control system was found to be either partly non-operational or operating with very less efficiency giving rise to huge fugitive emission from the unit.

WHEREAS, a technical hearing was conducted at the Head Office of the Board on 20/04/2010 involving the industry.

WHEREAS, the President of the industry appearing in the hearing submitted that they are taking necessary steps for controlling the emission from the induction furnaces and are in the process of modification / upgradation of the emission control system.

NOW THEREFORE, considering the observation of the inspecting officials of the Board and the submission made by the industry, **M/S. JAYPEE ALLOY & CASTINGS PVT. LTD.** is hereby directed as under :

1. **THAT,** the industry is allowed two (02) months time from hereof to modify/upgrade its emission control system for the induction furnaces.
2. **THAT,** the industry should submit a Bank Guarantee (proforma enclosed) of Rs. 2.00 lakhs. (Rupees two lakhs) only valid for twelve [12] months within fifteen [15] days from the date of issue of this direction in favour of the **WEST BENGAL POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD**, as an assurance to comply with the above direction within stipulated time frame.

If the industry fails to comply with the directions of the Board within the stipulated time period, the Board will be compelled to take stricter regulatory action.

This direction is issued in exercise of the powers conferred under the provision of Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, and Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and Rules made thereunder.

This has the approval of the Competent Authority.
