CLOSURE ORDER WITH DISCONNECTION OF ELECTRICITY

WHEREAS, M/s. FTC Exim Pvt. Ltd. (hereinafter referred to as the industry) located at Plot no. 77, Uluberia Industrial Growth Centre, Uluberia, Howrah – 711 316, P.S. Uluberia is engaged in manufacturing of mainly ferroalloys by alumini therming process.

WHEREAS, a complaint was lodged against the industry for causing air pollution in the locality.

WHEREAS, the industry was inspected by officials of the **West Bengal Pollution Control Board** (hereinafter referred to as the Board) on 18/05/2010 and the following non-compliance were noted :

1. The six (06) reaction vessels are not provided with any air pollution control system.
2. The slag crusher and slag grinder are not provided with any air pollution control system.
3. Housekeeping of the industry was found unsatisfactory.

WHEREAS, a hearing of the industry was conducted at the Head Office of the Board on 22/05/2010 involving the complainant and the industry.

NOW THEREFORE, considering the nature of non-compliance as observed by the inspecting officials, **M/s. FTC Exim Pvt. Ltd.** is hereby closed by the Board with immediate effect. The electricity connection of the industry is directed to be disconnected forthwith.

The Director (HR), WBSSEDCL is requested to take necessary steps to disconnect the electricity connection of the industry immediately.

This order will take immediate effect and the Officer-in-Charge, P.S. Uluberia is directed to execute closure order against the aforementioned industry and submit compliance report to the Board within seven days from receipt of this Memo.

This direction has been issued to the Officer-in-Charge, Uluberia Police Station and the Director (HR), WBSSEDCL in conformity with the order of the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta dt.21/08/1998 and 28/04/1999 respectively.

The Environmental Engineer, Howrah Regional Office of the Board is requested to take necessary steps for proper execution of the closure order and also visit the industry involving local police station and Nodal Police Officer.

This direction is issued in exercise of the powers conferred under the provision of Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and Rules made thereunder.

This has the approval of the Competent Authority.
