### **DIRECTION**

**WHEREAS**, M/s. Alsen Industries (hereinafter referred to as the industry) operates its alkyd resins and leather chemicals manufacturing unit at Vill.- Ramdevpur, P.O.- Khagramuri, P.S.- Bishnupur, Dist.- South 24 Pgs., Pin – 743 313.

**WHEREAS**, the industry was inspected on 14/09/2009 and 04/11/2009 by officials of the **WEST BENGAL POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD** (hereinafter referred to as the Board). It was observed during inspection that the industry has already installed one pre-mixer, one extruder, one grinding machine and one siever for production of epoxy powder, as a part of an expansion unit without obtaining N.O.C. from the Board.

**WHEREAS**, the industry was called for a technical hearing on 20/05/2010 at the head office of the Board due to its installation of an expansion unit for production of epoxy and polyester powder from polyester resin and epoxy resin without obtaining necessary permission from the Board.

**WHEREAS**, the Proprietor of the industry appearing in the hearing admitted the mistake on their part and mentioned that they will not operate the expansion activity before receiving NOC from the Board.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, considering the observation of the inspecting officials and the submission made by the industry, **M/s. Alsen Industries** is hereby directed not to start any production activity for their expansion unit before receiving Consent to Establish and Consent to Operate from the Board. The industry is further directed to submit a stamp paper undertaking regarding the above within 7 (seven) days from the issuance of this order. The industry is also directed to submit a detailed description of the manufacturing process along with flow chart for their proposed expansion activity.

The Environmental Engineer, Alipore Regional Office of the Board is requested to oversee the compliance of this direction and send report to the headquarters accordingly. If the industry is still found continuing to violate the above directions, the Board will be at liberty to take regulatory action including closure of the whole industry.

This direction is issued in exercise of the powers conferred under the provision of Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, and Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and Rules made thereunder after being approved by the Competent Authority.
