**SUSPENSION OF CLOSURE ORDER WITH RESTORATION OF ELECTRICITY**

In due consideration of the appeal made by the industry through its letter dated 12/07/2010 and the report of inspection by officials of the **West Bengal Pollution Control Board** (hereinafter referred to as the Board) dated 08/07/2010 and 09/07/2010 and also the submission of Bank Guarantee amount of Rs.5,00,000/- (Rupees Five lakhs) only by the industry in compliance with the directions of the Board, the Board is hereby pleased to suspend the order for closure for **02 (two) months** only from the date of issuance of this order against **M/s. RISHABH SPONGE LTD.** (hereinafter referred to as the industry) located at Durgapur Bankura Main Road, P.O. & P.S.– Barjora, Dist. Bankura, Pin – 722 202 West Bengal issued vide Memo No. 1178-173/WPB/SEE(KO)Gen/2004 (Pt-I) dt. 06/07/2010 with the following conditions : -

1. **THAT** the industry will ensure continuous and smooth functioning of the pollution abatement systems in all unit operations of the plant and comply with the stack emission standards and fugitive emission standards.
2. **THAT** the industry will take necessary steps for regular compliance of the six point directives issued by the Board for minimization of fugitive emission.
3. **THAT** the industry will install suitable D.G. Set capable of running all pollution control devices, rotary kilns and other necessary equipments / machinery during power cut.

**The electricity connection of the industry is ordered to be restored with immediate effect.**

The Director (HR), WBSEDCL is requested to take necessary steps for restoration of electricity connection of the above mentioned industry immediately.

The industry will be inspected by the Environmental Engineer, Durgapur Regional Office after suspension of closure order to verify the efficacy of the pollution abatement systems. If the industry is still found to operate violating the environmental norms and the directions issued by the Board, the Board will be at liberty to take further stricter regulatory action against the industry.

This direction is issued in exercise of the powers conferred under the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and Rules made thereunder and has the approval of the Competent Authority.
