SUSPENSION OF CLOSURE ORDER

In due consideration of the report of inspection conducted by the officials of the **WEST BENGAL POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD** (hereinafter referred to as the Board) on 31/07/2010 and the appeals submitted by the industry through its letters dated 17/07/2010, 26/07/2010, 28/07/2010 and 09/08/2010 for suspension of closure order and also for reduction of the pollution cost, the Board is pleased to hereby suspend the order for closure issued vide Memo No. 1203-192/WPB/SEE(KO)-Gen/2004 dt. 08/07/2010 against **M/s. Bisco Metal & Power Limited** (hereinafter referred to as the industry) located at P.O.Rangadih, P.S. Balarampur, Dt. Purulia, 723143 for a period of **six (06) months only** from hereof with the following conditions :

- i) **That** the industry should always operate in compliance with the environmental norms with efficient functioning of the pollution abatement systems and comply with the directions issued by the Board.
- ii) **That** instead of a Pollution Cost of Rs.5,00,000/- (Rupees Five Lakhs) as mentioned in the order for closure issued vide Memo No.1203-192/WPB/SEE(KO)-Gen/2004 dt.08/07/2010, the industry is hereby directed to submit a Pollution Cost of **Rs.4,00,000/-** (Rupees Four Lakhs) only as per the decision of the competent authority within fifteen [15] days from the date of issue of this order by Demand Draft to be drawn on Service Branch, Kolkata / Banker's cheque in favour of the **WEST BENGAL POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD** for the successive non-compliance of environmental norms.

The Asst. Env. Engineer and In-Charge, Asansol Sub-Regional Office of the Board is requested to inspect the industry to verify the efficacy of the pollution abatement systems. If the industry is still found to operate violating the environmental norms and the directions issued by the Board, the Board will be at liberty to take further stricter regulatory action against the industry.

This direction is issued in exercise of the powers conferred under the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and Rules made thereunder after being approved by the competent authority.
