DIRECTION

In due consideration of the appeal made by the industry through its letter dated 02/08/2010 and the report of inspection by officials of the **West Bengal Pollution Control Board** (hereinafter referred to as the Board) dated 02/08/2010 and also the submission of Bank Guarantee amount of Rs.5,00,000/- (Rupees Five lakhs) only and Pollution Cost of Rs.3,00,000/- (Rupees Three lakhs) only by the industry in compliance with the earlier directions of the Board, the Board is hereby pleased to suspend the spot-order for non-operation of the industry for **a period upto 31/10/2010** only against **M/s. SRI GAYATRI MINERALS PVT. LTD.** (hereinafter referred to as the industry) located at WBIIDC Growth Centre, Dwarika, P.O. & P.S. - Bishnupur, Dist.- Bankura with the following conditions : -

1. **THAT** the industry shall ensure complete installation and commissioning of bag filter system replacing the wet scrubber within 31/10/2010.
2. **THAT** the industry shall operate at 50% production capacity till commissioning of the adequate air pollution control system.
3. **THAT** the industry shall efficiently operate all its existing air pollution control systems during operation of the plant and comply with stack emission standards and fugitive emission standards.
4. **THAT** the industry by reducing the production capacity, shall meet all environmental norms.
5. **THAT** during the interim period **upto 31/10/2010**, the industry shall obtain electricity from the WBSSEDCL at 50% load only.

The Director (HR), WBSSEDCL is requested to take necessary steps for distribution of electricity to the above mentioned industry in such a manner so that it can operate at 50% production capacity only with immediate effect.

The Environmental Engineer, Durgapur Regional Office is requested to grant Consent to Operate to the industry for a period upto 31/10/2010 and to keep the industry under continuous surveillance in order to ensure compliance of the aforementioned directions issued by the Board. If the industry is still found to operate violating the environmental norms and directions issued by the Board, the Board will be at liberty to take further stricter regulatory action against the industry.

This direction is issued in exercise of the powers conferred under the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and Rules made thereunder and has the approval of the Competent Authority.
