SUSPENSION OF CLOSURE ORDER WITH RESTORATION OF ELECTRICITY

WHEREAS, M/s. A.D. Electro Steel Co. Pvt. Ltd., (hereinafter referred to as the industry) engaged in the manufacture of steel casting at Baltikuri (Surkimill), Kalitala, P.S.- Jagachha, Dist.- Howrah, Pin – 711 402.

AND WHEREAS, the industry was issued Closure Order with Disconnection of Electricity by the **WEST BENGAL POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD** (hereinafter referred to as the Board) vide Order of the Board bearing Memo No. 513/ PCB/How/176-98 dated 21/03/2011

AND WHEREAS, the industry submitted a prayer for suspension of closure order and restoration of electricity vide letter dt. 04/04/2011 and subsequently inspection of the industry was carried out by Board Officials on the same day. Inspection report mentions that the industry was not in operation and electricity connection was disconnected, the industry has rectified the perforated ducts leading to the air pollution control device.

NOW THEREFORE, in due consideration of the prayer made by the industry and the observations made during inspection, the Board is here by pleased to allow **M/s. A.D. Electro Steel Co. Pvt. Ltd.** to operate for a period of **eight (08) weeks only** from the date of issuance of this order to judge the efficiency of the pollution control system and subject to the condition that the industry should not operate the Induction Furnace of capacity 1 MT which has been erected without obtaining 'Consent to Establish' and 'Consent to Operate' from the Board.

The Director (HR), WBSEDCL is requested to take necessary steps for restoration of electricity connection of the above mentioned industry immediately.

The Asst. Environmental Engineer, In-Charge, Howrah Regional Office is requested to inspect the industry after suspension of closure order to verify the whether the industry is maintaining environmental norms and directions of the Board. If the industry is still found to operate violating the environmental norms and the directions issued by the Board, the Board will be at liberty to take further stricter regulatory action against the industry.

This direction is issued in exercise of the powers conferred under the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and Rules made thereunder after being approved by the Competent Authority.
