### **DIRECTION**

**WHEREAS, M/s. Sadhan Mondal** (hereinafter referred to as the unit) is operating a steel almirah manufacturing industry, located at B/20/H/10/1, Ultadanga Road, P.S- Ultadanga, Kolkata – 700 004.

**AND WHEREAS,** it is learnt from the records kept and maintained by the **WEST BENGAL POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD** (hereinafter referred to as the Board) that the unit had obtained Consent to Establish under Green category from DIC for manufacturing steel furniture without spray painting. Subsequently, the unit obtained Consent to Operate from the Board under Green category, which expired on 30.06.2008. Further, the unit had applied for renewal of Consent to Operate only on 20/04/2009 for manufacturing of steel furniture without spray painting.

**AND WHEREAS,** the unit was inspected by the State Board on 26/10/2010 during which the following non-compliance were observed :

- **That,** the unit is having one spray painting machine, which is not permitted as per Consent conditions and also constitutes a violation of the siting policy of the Board.
- **That,** the industry has no air pollution control device for the spray painting activity.

**AND WHEREAS,** the unit was called for a technical hearing at the Head Office of the Board on 25/02/2011 for continuing its manufacturing operations violating the environmental norms and also violating the siting policy of the Board. The proprietor of the unit appearing in the hearing could not submit any proper explanation for the above non-compliance and also mentioned that he was willing to abide by the directions issued by the Board.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** considering the observation of the inspecting officials and submission made by the proprietor, the unit is hereby **directed to stop all spray painting operations immediately.** The unit is also directed to submit a stamp paper undertaking within 10 [ten] days mentioning that it will not undertake any further spray painting operations and the total spray painting activity including machinery (compressor, spray gun etc.) will be removed from the premises of the unit.

The Environmental Engineer, Salt Lake Regional Office, of the Board is requested to conduct a fresh inspection of the unit immediately to verify its compliance with the above direction. If it is still found to be violating the Board's direction, strict regulatory action including closure order with disconnection of electricity may be issued.

This direction is issued in exercise of the powers conferred under the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and Rules made thereunder after being approved by the competent authority.
