**DIRECTION**

WHEREAS **M/S. KUNJ BIHARI STEEL (P) LTD.** (hereinafter referred as the industry) having its sponge iron unit with capacity of 100 t./day (one rotary kiln) at Jamuria Industrial Area, P. O. – Nandi, P. S. – Jamuria, Dist. – Burdwan, PIN – 713 344 is failing to comply with the environmental norms in respect of particulate emission standard.

WHEREAS, an inspection was carried out by the Regional Officer of the Board on 06-12-2006. From the inspection report it is revealed that on the day of inspection report the industry was operating only one field of ESP resulting in high emission from stack as well as high secondary emission. Fugitive emission was also observed from the cooler discharge unit.

WHEREAS, a hearing was conducted involving the industry on 12-01-2007 at the Head Office of the West Bengal Pollution Control Board.

WHEREAS, in the hearing in the hearing the industry submitted that there was some problem in control panel resulting in non-functioning of the 2<sup>nd</sup> field of ESP. The industry also submitted that ECMCS will be installed on 15-01-2007

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred under Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and Rules made thereunder **M/S. KUNJ BIHARI STEEL (P) LTD.**, is hereby directed as follows

1. That, the industry should not operate their unit without operating the ESP.
2. That the industry is allowed three months time to sort out its environmental problem and rectify the faults of the air pollution control systems.
3. That, the industry will submit a Bank Guarantee (Proforma enclosed) of Rs.5,00,000/- (Rupees Five Lakhs only) in favour of the WEST BENGAL POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD to ensure compliance of the above direction within fifteen (15) days from the date hereof.

In case of the non-compliance of the above directions by the industry within the stipulated time, the Board may have to issue necessary regulatory order without any further reference.

This has the approval of the Competent Authority.
