**DIRECTION**

WHEREAS, **M/S. RITESH TRADE FIN LTD.** (hereinafter referred as the industry) located at Plot No. 3513(P), Lenin Sarani, Durgapur, Dist. – Burdwan, PIN – 713 210, denied entry to the inspecting officers of the West Bengal Pollution Control Board, hereinafter referred as the “Board” to the unit during a night monitoring exercise on 10-11-2006 violating the provisions of Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act and the Environmental (Protection) Act.

WHEREAS, a hearing was conducted involving the industry on 01-12-2006 at the Head Office of the West Bengal Pollution Control Board.

WHEREAS, in the hearing Shri Ritesh Agarwal, Director of the Industry agreed that denying entry of the inspecting team of the Pollution Control Board was a serious mistake on their part and submitted that this will not happen in future again.

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred under Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and Rules made thereunder **M/S. RITESH TRADE FIN LTD.**, is hereby directed as follows

1. That, the industry should keep senior officer on duty during the night time for taking care of the pollution abatement system and never deny entry to the Board’s inspecting officials to the unit at any time of the day or night.
2. That the said unit should submit Pollution Cost of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakh) only, within fifteen (15) days from the date hereof by Demand Draft to be drawn on Service Branch, Kolkata/Banker’s Cheque in favour of West Bengal Pollution Control Board for denying entry to Board’s officials and thus preventing them for discharging their duties.

In case of the non-compliance of the above directions by the industry within the stipulated time, the Board may have to issue necessary regulatory order without any further reference.

This has the approval of the Competent Authority.
