**DIRECTION**

WHEREAS, a public complaint was made before the West Bengal Pollution Control Board against **M/S. UNISTAR GALVANISERS & FABRICATORS PVT. LTD.**, located at P. O. – Ganganagar, P.S. – Airport, Dist. – 24 Prganas (North) for emanating acid fumes from the pickling operation causing health problem in the local area.

WHEREAS, an inspection was carried out by the Asstt. Environmental Engineer, Technical Cell of the West Bengal Pollution Control Board, hereinafter referred as “the Board” on 06-11-2006 .

WHEREAS, a public hearing was conducted involving both representatives of M/s. **M/S. UNISTAR GALVANISERS & FABRICATORS PVT. LTD.** and the complainant on 17-11-2006 at the Head Office of the West Bengal Pollution Control Board.

WHEREAS, in the public hearing it was agreed by both the parties that the unit may be granted three months time for installation of emission abatement system for arresting acid fumes from pickling bath.

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred under Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and Rules made thereunder **M/S. UNISTAR GALVANISERS & FABRICATORS PVT. LTD.**, located P. O. – Ganganagar, P. S. – Airport, Dist. – 24 Parganas (North) is hereby directed to take following measure to minimize the air pollution problem with February, 2007.

1. That, the industry will install emission abatement system for arresting acid fumes from pickling bath within February 28, 2007.
2. That, the industry will modify the suction device for arresting fumes over zinc bath so that no secondary emission from the zinc bath takes place.
3. That, the unit will submit a Bank Guarantee of Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand only) within seven (7) days form the date of issue of this order favouring West Bengal Pollution Control Board to ensure compliance of the above direction.

In case of the non-compliance of the above directions by the industry within the stipulated time, the Board may have to issue necessary regulatory order without any further reference.

This has the approval of the Competent Authority.
