SUSPENSION OF CLOSURE ORDER

In due consideration of the appeal made by the industry for suspension of closure order through its letter dated 23-04-2008 and the report of inspection dated 28-04-2008 which revealed that the industry has installed and commissioned the pneumatic conveying system along with silo & pug mill for transferring ESP dust, taken steps for minimizing leakage from ABC cap of the rotary kilns and other secondary emissions, the closure order issued by the Board vide Memo No.134-239-WPB-SEE-K.O.-GEN/2004 dated 09/10/04-2008 against **M/S. GOVINDA IMPEX LIMITED**, located at Mouza – Sahebdihi, P.S. – Barjora, Dist. – Bankura is hereby withdrawn by the Board with the following conditions:

1. That, the industry should immediately remove coal char and dolo char from the open space and ensure no such accumulation in future.
2. That, the industry should also ensure that there is no emission from the top of ABC cap.
3. That the industry should immediately comply with the particulate emission standard for all the unit operations.
4. That, the industry will always operate its pollution control systems during its manufacturing process.
5. That, the industry will take a shut down of its manufacturing process whenever the pollution abatement system fails to function for whatever reasons and the same should be intimated to the Board.

In case of noncompliance of any of the above directions by the industry, the Board will issue closure order without any further reference in the matter.
