**SUSPENSION OF CLOSURE ORDER WITH RESTORATION OF ELECTRICITY**

In due consideration of the appeal of the industry dated 04/02/2013 to the **West Bengal Pollution Control Board** (hereinafter referred to as the Board) for suspension of closure, report of inspection conducted by the Board officials on 06/02/13 and the undertaking submitted by the industry through non-judicial stamp paper on 21/02/13, the Board is hereby pleased to **suspend** the Order for Closure along with Disconnection of Electricity issued vide Memo 2608-WPBA/Red(BWN)/Cont.(523)/06 Dated 16 / 01/2012 against **M/s. Maa Kalyaneswari Hard Coke & Coke Briquette** (hereinafter referred to as the industry) located at Mouza-Deghari, P.O.- Salanpur, P.S.- Kulti, Dist.- Burdwan.

The industry is directed to comply with the following conditions:-

1. **That**, the industry shall operate complying with all the environmental norms with efficient functioning of air pollution control devices attached to coke ovens.
2. **That** the industry shall not operate the additional 14 ovens before obtaining Consent to Establish and Consent to Operate from the Board.
3. **That**, the industry shall submit a Pollution Cost of Rs 25,000 /- (Rupees twenty five thousand) only within fifteen [15] days from the date hereof by Demand Draft to be drawn on Service Branch, Kolkata/Banker's cheque in favour of the **WEST BENGAL POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD**.

**The electricity connection of the industry is ordered to be restored with immediate effect.**

**The Director (HR), WBSEDCL** is requested to take necessary steps for restoration of electricity connection of the above mentioned industry immediately.

The Assistant Environmental Engineer & In-charge, Asansol Sub-regional Office of the Board is requested to monitor the industry for compliance of the directions mentioned above. If the industry is again found to operate violating the environmental norms and the directions issued by the Board and the above conditions, the Board will be at liberty to take stricter regulatory action against the industry.

This order has the approval of the Competent Authority.
